Queensland Interclub Competition

Rules of Participation

- 1. **Eligibility**: The competition is open to all clubs in Queensland regardless of their affiliation status with the Queensland Philatelic Council.
- 2. Sheets: Fifteen (15) sheets, maximum height 290mm, maximum width 240mm
- 3. **Material**: General or Thematic. Specialised studies are not suitable
- 4. **Entries:** A minimum of three club members must contribute the material for the entry. All sheets must be enclosed in close fitting clear plastic protectors. All sheets numbered 1-15 (in correct order) on the back of each page. The Secretary of QPC should be advised of a club's desire to participate not less than fourteen days prior to the competition and entries lodged the day prior to the event. Any other delivery arrangements must be made with the QPC secretary, however adequate time for mounting the entry will be taken into consideration.

5. **Judging**:

The competition will be judged by popular vote, each attendee receiving one voting slip. Voting is by optional preferential voting. Counting will commence at the discretion of the organising committee.

- 6. **Fees**: No entry fee is payable
- 7.**Trophies**:- The Queensland Interclub Competition has a perpetual trophy which will have the successful club's name engraved thereon. A small trophy, duly engraved will be presented to the club to keep.
